Fun fact: Until the 1980s, Casablanca was used for grazing livestock or growing wheat. That was until Pablo Morandé, then working for Concha y Toro, noticed its similarity to coastal California, hence its potential for cooler-climate premium wine styles.

These 100% hand harvested, estate wines show the true expression of the Casablanca Valley. This collaborative project between Brazos and Grupo Belén began with the idea to showcase the unique terroir of the Casablanca Valley. The valley produces vibrant and fresh profiled wines due to the coastal, cool nature of the vineyards. The estate consists of multiple vineyards including some of the original plantings in Casablanca by Pablo Morandé in 1982. The cool misty nights, hot sunny days, and light hand of the winemaker act as a prism to convert the grape into a complex and beautiful wine.



2024 Prisma Sauvignon Blanc

This hand-harvested, cold soaked, un-oaked, 100% Sauvignon Blanc is produced from a blend of two Casablanca Valley vineyards: Belén and El Principal. Stainless steel. The sandy, clay soils and cool, coastal climate contribute to a bright, fresh character in the wine. Aged in stainless steel. Passion fruit and mango jump out of the glass with underlying citrus notes of lemon, lime and grapefruit, combined with a mineral undertone lead to a crisp, elegant and well-balanced finish.



2024 Prisma Rosé of Pinot Noir

87% Pinot Noir, 13% Cinsault. Belén Vineyard on clay and granitic soil. 5 months in stainless steel tank. Two-hour maceration, 20 days fermented, on lees for 2 months. Shows notes of fresh citrus, crushed stone, passion fruit, grapefruit rind, and watermelon on the nose. The palate is high toned with bright acid, red fruit, and peach flavors that lead to a mouthwatering finish. A solid crushed wet rock backbone and watermelon juice notes.



2022 Prisma Pinot Noir

100% Pinot Noir from the single vineyard Belén. Cold maceration in stainless steel, oak fermentation. Aged 8 months in varied sizes of French oak barrels. Granite soils and cool, coastal climate produce a fresh, vibrant aromatic wine. It shows bright red fruit notes of strawberry and cherry, with an underlying hint of oak, that leads to a lifted mid-palate and smooth, velvety finish.
