To push the boundaries and create the very first dry white wine from Bordeaux at an affordable price, is the ambition that drove Denis Dubourdieu and Dourthe with the creation of N°1. The concept came to light in the 1980s. A time in Bordeaux when the great red wines reign supreme, leaving their white counterparts – of dubious quality – languishing in the shadows. From this realization was born the idea of producing quality white grapes of perfect ripeness. In addition to the many interventions carried out in the vineyard, new techniques are introduced in the winery to extract the full potential the berries can offer. Inspired by the prestigious white wines of Sancerre, N°1 Blanc is made exclusively from Sauvignon Blanc grapes. Another revelation in a world where Semillon is king.

Only the best terroir across Bordeaux: Silty and sandy-silt soils with clay sub-soil (ideal for intense, expressive, and highly aromatic white wine), clay and clay-limestone soil (imparts depth, aromatic complexity, and great finesse). Skin contact maceration and low temperature fermentation enhance the aromatic richness and unique character. Ages 6 months on the lees in stainless steel vats.

<u>90 Points - James Suckling</u> - "Fresh and aromatic with pleasant quince, green apple and guava that show varietal character. This is crisp and elegant on the palate with bright acidity and a bone-dry finish."

<u>90 Points - Decanter</u> - "Lively and vibrant, a nice push of peach, apricot, lemon and lime with crisp green apple. Creamy and soft, a gentle expression, but really works with enough acidity to be appealing and weight to give more of a gourmet feel. Lovely cool expression. So drinkable."
