Local Knowledge. Traditional Techniques. Field Recordings is 35-year old winemaker Andrew Jones' personal catalog of the people and places he values most. Spending his days as a vine nursery fieldman planning and planting vineyards for farmers all over California, Andrew is sometimes offered small lots of their best fruit on the side. Having stood in just about every vineyard on the Central Coast, he has a keen eye for diamonds in the rough: sites that are unknown or underappreciated but hold



enormous untapped potential. As friendships are made and opportunities are embraced, Andrew produces small quantities of soulful wine from these unusual, quiet vineyards. The Field Recordings wines are a catalog of single vineyard sites that produces wines with a sense of place and personality. In addition to the single vineyard wines, multi-vineyard blends are put together under the Wonderwall, Alloy Wine Works, and FICTION

labels. Wonderwall focuses on Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from extreme, coastal locations. Breaking through and breaking rules. Alloy Wine Works is a collection of varietal wines packaged in cans. FICTION, the original spin-off label, is a white and red wine produced from multiple vineyards and multiple varieties. Taking what the season gives us and creating a blend made for every occasion. Ready for tonight, tomorrow or this weekend.



2020 Champs, Paso Robles



Varietals: 100% Pinot Meunier

Vineyards: Derbyshire

To expand on our sparkling wine-making skills we started a methode champenoise in 2020 using this underdog sparkling grape from the old world that is the only of its kind grown on the SLO Coast. On tirage for 30 months and disgorged in July of 2023. Enjoy, this is our toast to you!

2023 'Fiction' Red Wine, Paso Robles



Varietals: 23% Zinfandel, 22% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Cabernet Franc, 16% Syrah, 8% Alicante Bouschet, 5% Lagrein, 5% Corvina, 4% Cinsault

Vineyards: Loomis (Organic), Hinterland (Organic), Bordonaro, Wilderness, Vukelich, Armory, Koligian

Fermentation: Fermented as whole berries; depending on the lot, we use 10-20% stems for added structure and spice. Punchdowns and/or pumpovers twice daily to keep the native yeast fermentation healthy and happy.

Élevage: 6 months in both American and French oak, 20% new

Tasting Notes: Fresh blueberries, hint of black pepper, cinnamon and cardamom. Tart black cherries and licorice on the palate, with a smooth and refreshing finish.

<u>93 Points - James Suckling</u> - "The nose offers an array of bright, lifted aromas of mulberries, cocoa and violets. The palate is medium-bodied with firmly integrated tannins and fresh acidity, showing notes of blood plums, raspberries, dark chocolate and licorice."

2023 Wonderwall Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara County



Vineyards: Morro View

Elevage: 12 months in French oak, 15% new

Fermentation: Open top fermentation in 1.5 ton bins for 17-23 days with

20% whole clusters

Élevage: 6 months in 100% French oak, 10% new

Tasting Notes: Raspberry, black cherries, Ceylon cinnamon, black pepper



2022 Chenin Blanc, Central Coast



Varietals: 100% Chenin Blanc

Vineyards: Shell Creek (organic), Jurassic Park (sustainable),

Cat Canyon (practicing organic)

Fermentation: 65% Neutral German Fuder, 35% Neutral Acacia Barrels

Élevage: Aged for 5 months sur lie

Tasting Notes: Meyer lemon, fresh quince, zest of lime, oyster shells, chamomile

2022 Hoss Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles



Varietals: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon **Vineyards**: The Armory, Huerhuero

Fermentation: Destemmed and fermented in open top bins for 12 to 20 days

Élevage: 11 months in 40% new French oak, 20% new American oak, 40% neutral oak

Tasting Notes: Blueberries, Cacao, Black Pepper, Ethiopian Coffee

2023 'Franc', Paso Robles



Varietals: 100% Cabernet Franc

Vineyards: Hinterland (Organic), Bordonaro

Fermentation: open top bins with 33% stem inclusion

Élevage: 8 months in American oak casks

Tasting Notes: blueberries, black cherries, red currants

and a touch of mint and rosemary

<u>92 Points - James Suckling</u> - "Not your traditional California cabernet franc. This leans more toward a Loire Valley style, with fresh, lifted aromas of wild blackberries, cassis, violets and potpourri. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins and bright acidity, showing notes of cranberries, pencil shavings and fresh herbs. Very well balanced and vibrant."

<u>91 Points - Vinous</u> - "Wickedly fresh, the 2023 Franc opens in the glass with blue and purple floral tones, hints of wet stone and black raspberries. This is racy with crunchy wild berry fruits elevated by violet inner florals and juicy acidity. It leaves a flowery concentration and a tinge of fine tannins through the finish."



2022 Rosé Pet Nat, Paso Robles



Varietals: 86% Cabernet Franc, 14% Chardonnay

Vineyards: Wine Porch (organic), Cat Canyon (organic), Madison, Magdalena **Fermentation**: Crushed and left on skins for 6 hours and pressed to stainless.

Fermented cold with native yeast and bottled before fermentation is complete to get just

the right amount of sparkle

Tasting Notes: Oxnard plains strawberries, fresh rosemary sourdough loaves and a

hint of jade citrus mint tea, watermelon jolly rancher.

NV Field Recordings Dry Hop Pet Nat, Arroyo Grande Valley



Varietals: 100% Chardonnay Vineyards: Coquina (Organic)

Fermentation: Fermented cold and slow in stainless for 3 weeks

on organic citra hops

Tasting Notes: Gooseberry, Lupulin, Pears

The fermentation occurred naturally and lasted 15 days before being racked off of its lees. We reserved a small portion of the fermenting juice in a temperature-controlled tank, which was added back to the wine before bottling. No non-grape sugar was used to finish the fermentation in the bottle. Dry Hop Pét Nat was our first foray into the Pét Nat revolution. The creation of this wine requires perfect timing. It must be captured in bottle at just the right level of natural sugar so it is perfectly carbonated upon release.

Varietals: 34% Chenin Blanc, 18% Pinot Gris, 12% Colombard, 9% Xarel.Lo, 8% Verdelho, 6% Vermentino, 3% Trousseau Gris, 3% Semillon, 3% Gewurztraminer, 2% Riesling, 2% Malvasia Bianca


Vineyards: Martin Brothers (Organic), Trousdale, Cat Canyon (Organic), Greengate Farms, Lockwood Valley, George Brown, Huerhuero, Shell Creek (Organic), Jurassic Park, Nolan, Creston Ridge (Organic), Millhouse (Organic), Zabala (Organic), Hinterland (Organic)

Fermentation: White grapes are destemmed and left on skins for 23 to 46 days.

Élevage: 100% barrel aged for 4 months in neutral French oak **Tasting Notes**: Flavors of apricot, Haitian orange and marzipan



2022/2023 Freddo, Paso Robles



Varietals: 76% Sangiovese, 24% Valdiguié

Vineyards: Creston Ridge (Sip Certified), Trousdale (Sip Certified),

Loomis (Organic), Shell Creek (Organic)

Fermentation: Partial carbonic fermentation to get the perfect balance of fresh fruit while maintaining a slightly rustic Italian funk. Fermented in sealed stainless steel tanks

for 7 days before pressing.

Élevage: 6 months in 100% stainless steel

Tasting Notes: Tastes like fresh cranberry, Montmorency cherries, strawberry

The ideal antipasto wine! We recommend serving with a chill — when the letters on the label turn blue, you know what to do (drink it).

Varietals: 100% Chardonnay

Vineyards: Hilliard Bruce, Zotovich, Shandon Hills


Fermentation: Whole cluster pressed Chardonnay. 70% fermented in neutral French

oak, 30% fermented in stainless steel

Élevage: 6 months in 70% French oak, 30% stainless steel

Tasting Notes: Opens up with a nose full of pears and clementines. Super fresh and clean like an ocean breeze. On the palate, ripe stone fruit, more citrus and pie crust

2022 Super Gnario, Happy Canyon of Santa Barbara



'The 15 Best Wines in 2023 So Far' -The Tasting Table

Produced with two grapes that aren't regularly associated with California: Nebbiolo and Barbera. Nebbiolo features predominantly, proving that the star variety of Italy's prestigious Barolo wines is at home on this side of the Atlantic.

Varietals: 85% Nebbiolo, 15% Barbera

Vineyards: Alta Gaviota

Fermentation: Open top fermentation in 1.5 ton bins for 45 days with 50% stem inclusion on the Nebbiolo. Barbera is fully destemmed and fermented

for 21 days in bins.

Élevage: 14 months in 100% French oak (10% new).



2023 Domo Arigato (Mr. Ramato), Central Coast



Varietals: A Ramato-style wine made from skin-contact Pinot Gris (hence the name).

We used a special barrel selection of our Pinot Gris lots used for Skins.

Vineyards: Greengate Farms

Fermentation: Destemmed and fermented on skins for 36 days before pressing to

neutral barrels

Elevage: 4 months in neutral French oak

Tasting Notes: Freeze dried strawberry, fresh apricot, hint of thyme

2022 About Time Organic Merlot, Paso Robles





Fermentation: Open top tanks for 14 days with daily pumpovers **Elevage**: 5 months in stainless steel, 5 months in neutral oak **Tasting Notes:** Vanilla spice latte, plum sauce, tobacco leaf

2022 Regenerator Organic Zinfandel



Classic California Zinfandel that showcases the spicy side of Zin while holding onto its bright berry flavors. Good to go with everything from burgers to filet mignon.

Varietal: Zinfandel

Fermentation: Open top tanks for 14 days with daily pumpovers

Elevage: 10 months in American oak, 25% new **Tasting Notes:** Black licorice, plums, Urfa pepper

2022 'All the Rage', Los Olivos District, Santa Barbara County



"All the Rage" is a fantastic red wine that packs a flavorful punch. Made from a blend of organic Cabernet Sauvignon (65%), Merlot (20% Merlot), Syrah (10%), and Marselan (5%) grapes grown in two vineyards (Coquilot and Deboem) in Santa Barbara County - one of them young and the other over three decades old, the wine offers a depth of character that is rich and complex. 100% neutral French oak. On the nose, the wine is vibrant with aromas of black cherry, red currant, and hints of chocolate. On the palate, the wine is silky, with a balanced acidity and tannins that are firm yet smooth. The flavors are bold and fruit-forward, with distinct notes of ripe plum, blackberry, and a touch of vanilla. Bottled without any fining, this wine maintains its true flavor and is ideal for those who appreciate organic wine. Stylistically similar to a Bordeaux village, "All the Rage" is bold yet elegant, perfect for pairing with grilled meats or hearty pasta dishes. It's an impressive wine that will make you the life of the party and satisfy even the most discerning of palates.

2022 'Soft Eyes' Rosé, Los Olivos District, Santa Barbara County



'Soft Eyes' Rosé is a beautiful, organic wine made from Grenache (93%) and Marselan (7%) grapes from Deboem Vineyard in Santa Barbara County. Native yeast fermentation in tank. Aged in 100% stainless steel. On the nose, this wine is bursting with bright aromas of fresh strawberries, crisp watermelon, and subtle notes of juicy citrus fruits. The palate is dominated by a stunning blend of tart raspberries, tangy cranberries, and hints of lemon zest that offer an incredible balance of tartness and sweetness. The wine is very refreshing, light and has a supple, silky texture that is augmented by a lingering acidity. It beautifully represents the Old World style of winemaking, with great attention to detail, bringing forth a delightful and unique tasting experience. It pairs perfectly with a fresh salad, grilled seafood, light pasta dishes, or just enjoyed on its own as an aperitif. Overall, Soft Eyes Rosé is a must-try wine, offering exceptional quality and value.

2022 Chillable Red Wine, Central Coast



"So Far Out" is an exciting new chillable red wine that is making waves in the wine world. Produced from organic and responsibly farmed grapes grown along California's central coast, this wine is the embodiment of a new wine revolution. Corvina (45%), Mourvèdre (30%), Grenache (20%), Charbono (5%) from Wilderness and Black Oak vineyards. Open top bin fermentation with native yeast. Aged in 95% stainless steel, 5% new oak. This red wine is light, refreshing and perfect served chilled, making it a perfect choice for those warm summer days at the beach, outdoor BBQs, or simply relaxing with friends. The blend, which is a closely guarded secret, is designed to highlight the characteristics of the terroir and the varietals used in the blend. With aromas of ripe red berries, and subtle hints of herbs, this wine is well balanced and smooth on the palate, with a light to medium body that is refreshing and juicy to the taste. The flavors are the perfect harmony of fruit, with hints of strawberry and raspberry and a slight acidity that lingers in the finish. "So Far Out" is the perfect wine for those who appreciate traditionally made, organic wine, and the push to move forward to a more sustainable future.
